CLASS DESCRIPTIONS SPRING 2008

Described below are the classes offered at Society for Handicapped. Some of these classes are only offered once a year. Please refer to our current registration form for availability. Books are not required, but are available for your purchase at the Society. Reminder: children under 13 may only attend classes with pre-approval from the Society and if accompanied by an adult.

BEGINNING SIGN LANGUAGE

This is our basic beginner's class. Some things that will be covered will be:

- *ABC's – manual alphabet
- *Days of the Week
- *Family Relationships
- *Emergency and Medical Signs
- *Animals
- *Colors
- *Months of the Year
- *Feelings and Emotions
- *Numbers
- *Variety of miscellaneous signs used in everyday conversation

We will be learning how to put our vocabulary words into sentences and how to express ourselves with gesture and body language.

INTERMEDIATE SIGN LANGUAGE

This class will work extensively on fingerspelling and how to read it. Through the use of games we will concentrate on more one-on-one communication. New vocabulary words will be taught each week and used in our sign conversation.

*In order to take this class, you must have a working knowledge of Beginning Sign, or equivalent.

ADVANCED/CONVERSATIONAL SIGN LANGUAGE

This class gives the student an opportunity to practice receptive and expressive sign language skills in a voice on/voice off environment. We will concentrate on conversational sign, socialization and grammar, and learn about ASL structure and deaf culture.

*In order to take this class, you must have a working knowledge of Intermediate Sign, or equivalent.

CHRISTMAS SIGNS/SONGS
